THIS APPLIANCE HAS A POLARIZED PLUG (ONE BLADE IS WIDER THAN THE OTHER). TO REDUCE THE RISK OF ELECTRIC SHOCK, THIS PLUG IS INTENDED TO FIT IN A POLARIZED OUTLET ONLY ONE WAY. IF THE PLUG DOES NOT FIT FULLY IN THE OUTLET, REVERSE THE PLUG. IF IT STILL DOES NOT FIT, CONTACT A QUALIFIED ELECTRICIAN TO INSTALL THE PROPER OUTLET.

DO NOT ATTEMPT TO MODIFY THIS PLUG OR DEFEAT THIS SAFETY FEATURE IN ANY WAY.

HOW TO USE YOUR HEATING PAD

Make sure Control Connector is securely attached to the Pad Connector (Figure 1). Push both parts together for a tight fit. NOTE: control must be connected to heating pad before plugging unit into outlet. 1. After control is connected to pad, plug into 120V AC electrical outlet. The LCD display

lights up and goes out immediately. This heating pad features RAPID-Heat. With this unique

fast-heat technology, you will feel heat in 30

seconds - for faster pain relief!

2. To turn the pad on, press the Power Button. The LCD display lights up. The default temperature setting is the Lowest setting (35'C) and the default timer setting is 1h.

Press Temp Button to select temperature settings. The setting grid increases one by one each time you press the button. The temperature figure changes accordingly (35-40-45-50-55-60-65-70'C). The pad starts heating immediately when you loose the button. When heated to the temperature of selected

setting, it stays at stable status. 4. Press Timer Button to select Auto-Off timing. The default setting is 1:00. The 6 timing sequence is: 1:00-1:30-2:00-00:15-00:30-00:45. When you loose the button, it starts countdown timing automatically by minute.

Press Temp Button for 2 to 3 seconds, it switches freely between Celcius and Fahrenheit.

6. If there is no more selection on the settings, the pad will turn into operation status, and reach out equilibrium condition 7. The pad will shut off automatically when time reaches the selected

setting. LCD display goes out as well. 8. DURING USE, NEVER PLACE THE CONTROLLER UNDER THE

PAD. 9. See additional warnings.

USING MOIST HEAT THERAPY

In some cases, you may find that moist heat therapy provides more comfort and relief. When using moist heat therapy, you should protect furniture and clothing from becoming damp.

1. Dampen either side of the heating pad with water by patting the surface with a wet sponge or cloth or use a spray bottle to apply a fine mist. Do not thoroughly soak pad. 2. Do not spray or dampen the pad connector. (Figure 3)

DANGER: Do not immerse the pad or wiring in water or place under running water. Failure to comply may result in product failure and/or personal injury.

NOTE: The electrical pad connector must be thoroughly dry before establishing electrical connection.

AUTO-OFF FEATURE

Your heating pad controller includes a selectable Auto-Off Your neating pad controller includes a selectable Auto-Off feature. By pressing the Timer Button, you can choose from 6 timer options. The default timer is 1:00. The sequence is: 1:00-1:30-2:00-00:15-00:30-00:45. NOTE: After a power outage, the Auto-Off feature automatically resets to the default timer.

WASHING INSTRUCTIONS

DO NOT DRY CLEAN! DO NOT BLEACH! DO NOT USE WRINGER FOR DETACHABLE PAD! 1 Disconnect pad from outlet

Detach Pad Connector from the Control Connector.

3. Wash by hand or as follows in an automatic washer using slow agitation and normal spin speed: *Fill washer with warm water. Add* minimum amount of all-purpose detergent, agitate to dissolve, measure heating pad before washing. Add heating pad and soak five minutes. Agitate two minutes. Spin. Fill for cool rinse, agitate one minute then spin. Dry in automatic dryer on high heat, five minutes only, or line dry. Remove damp heating pad from dryer, block to original size, and drape to finish drying. Do not iron your heating pad. 4. Do not plug in pad and pad connector until they are completely dry.
